What is the purpose of the meeting?

The traditional boundaries between physical and life sciences and life sciences have never been more porous. Scientists today need to have a broader understanding of new research areas, emerging and traditional experimental methods – often in areas well outside of their home discipline.

This meeting is focussed on bringing scientists together to learn from each other – both in lectures and workshops and as a consequence of living, eating, drinking and socialising together in an a mountain hut, far away from other distractions. It is likely that the format this year will be that students will give short research talks, and professors longer teaching style lectures.
